



Basic FATE (Focus Assessed Transthoracic Echocardiography)

FATE is the original focused echo protocol practiced since 1989. FATE is easily and quickly learned and can be applied in a multitude of clinical scenarios – eg pre-, peri and postoperatively, intensive care medicine, emergencies, resuscitation, ambulances, it has no limitations. FATE can be performed with the patient in a sitting position.

FATE also provides a quick guidance to interpret sonocardiographic findings and to put them into clinical context.

There are two FATE levels:

Basic FATE one day course: Based on two dimensional imaging of the easiest cardiac views including M-mode.

Advanced FATE one day course: Basic FATE supplied with extended cardiac views and Doppler ultrasound for cardiac output and pressure measurement together with assessment of left ventricle diastolic function.

Objective

Provide the attendees with basic sonocardiographic needs for the non-cardiologist in order to guide cardio-pulmonary optimization.

Who Can Attend?

Physicians of all specialties, e.g. anesthesiologists, intensivists, emergency physicians, internists, surgeons, general practitioners.
